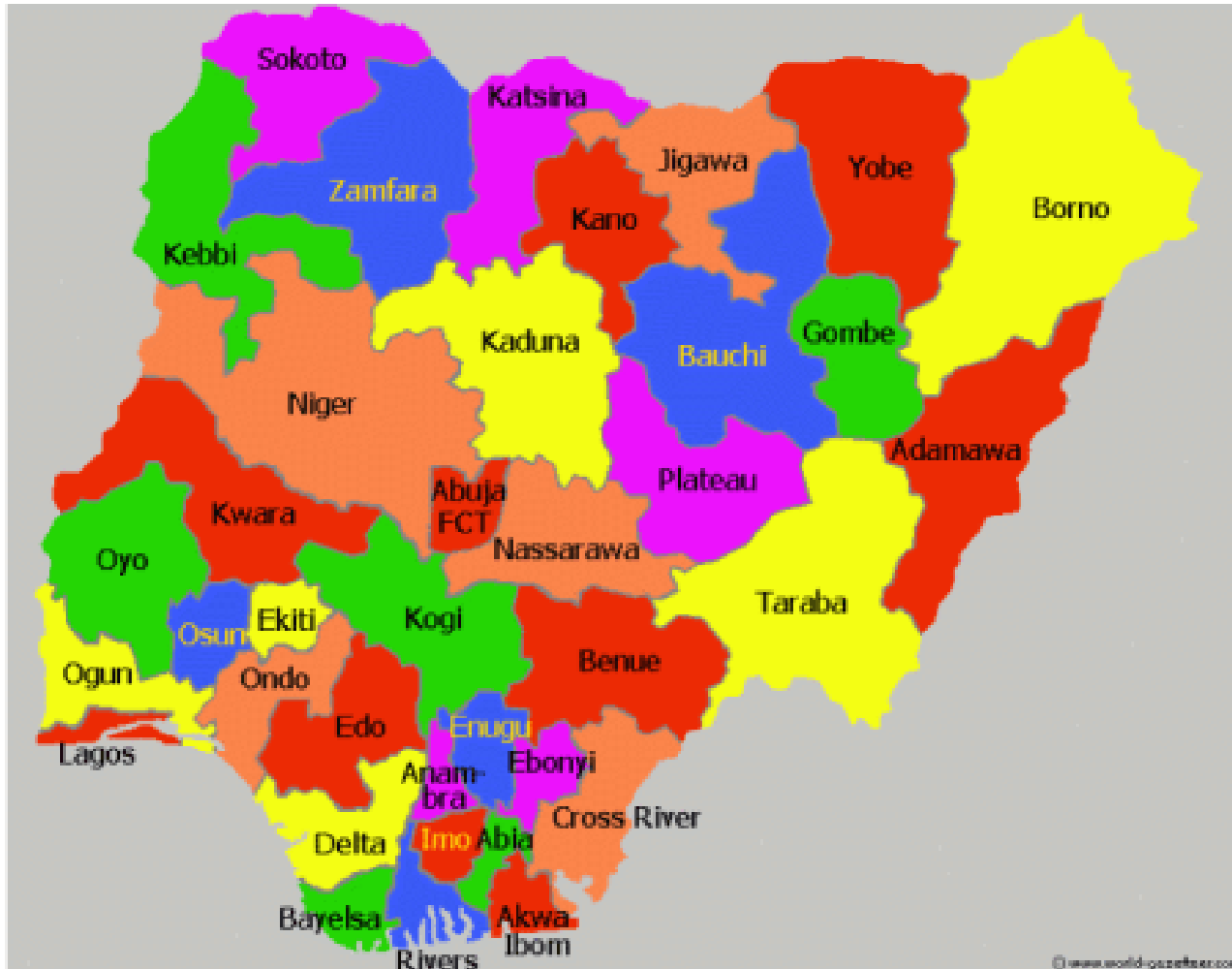


NIGERIAN MAP

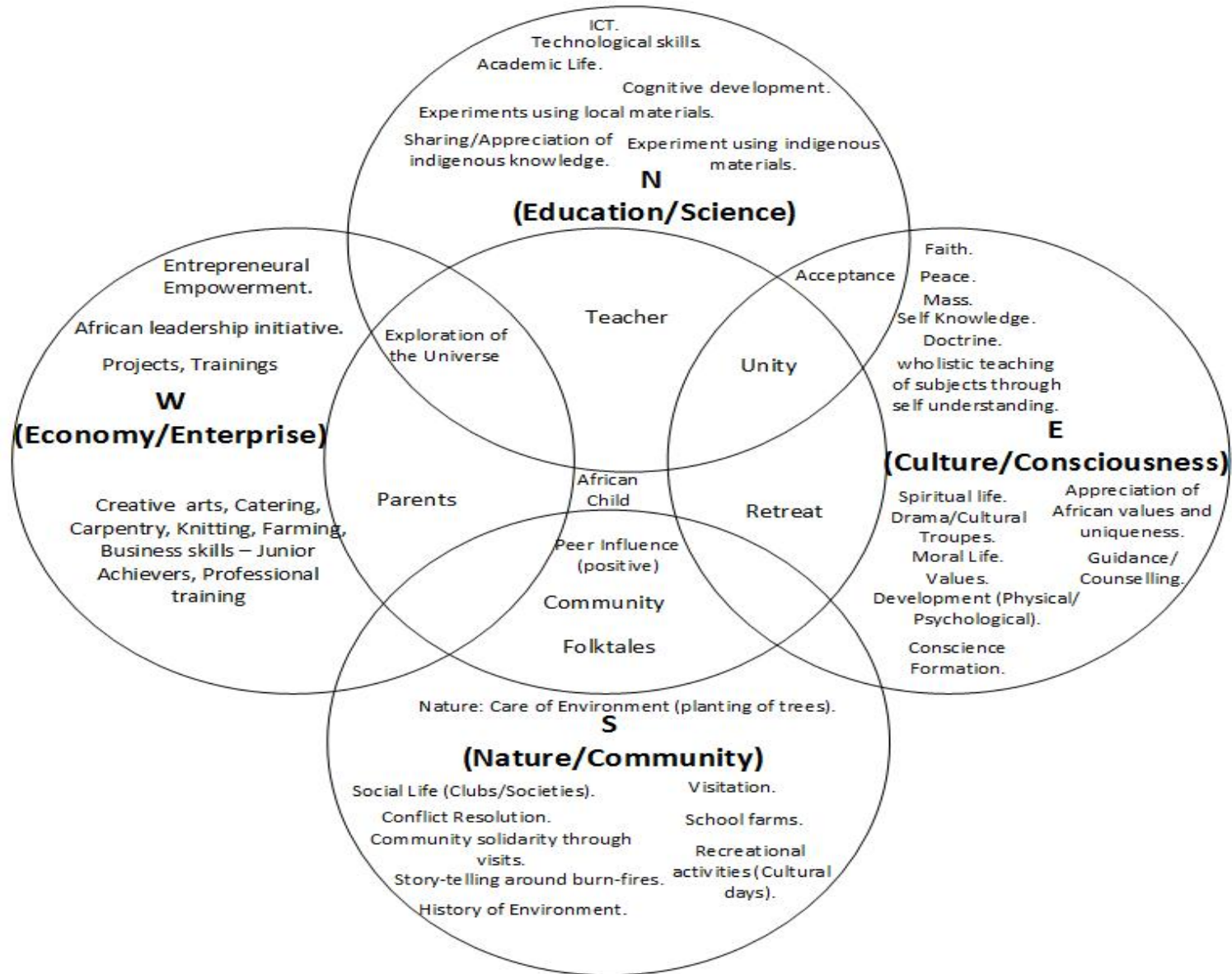


OUR INTEGRAL RESPONSE TO THE EMERGING ISSUES

- Indigenous herbal medicine translating into an integral healing approach using the Integral four world model (Lessem and Schiffer)
 - S- *Physical (providing herbs for healing)*
 - E- *Spiritual, (understanding their cultural and spiritual interpretation of reality)*
 - N- *Intellectual (facilitating deeper understanding and knowledge about their reality)*
 - W- *Economical (how to create a livelihood out of their reality)*
- We have replicated this approach in Jos Northern and are work in collaboration with Fr Adodo.

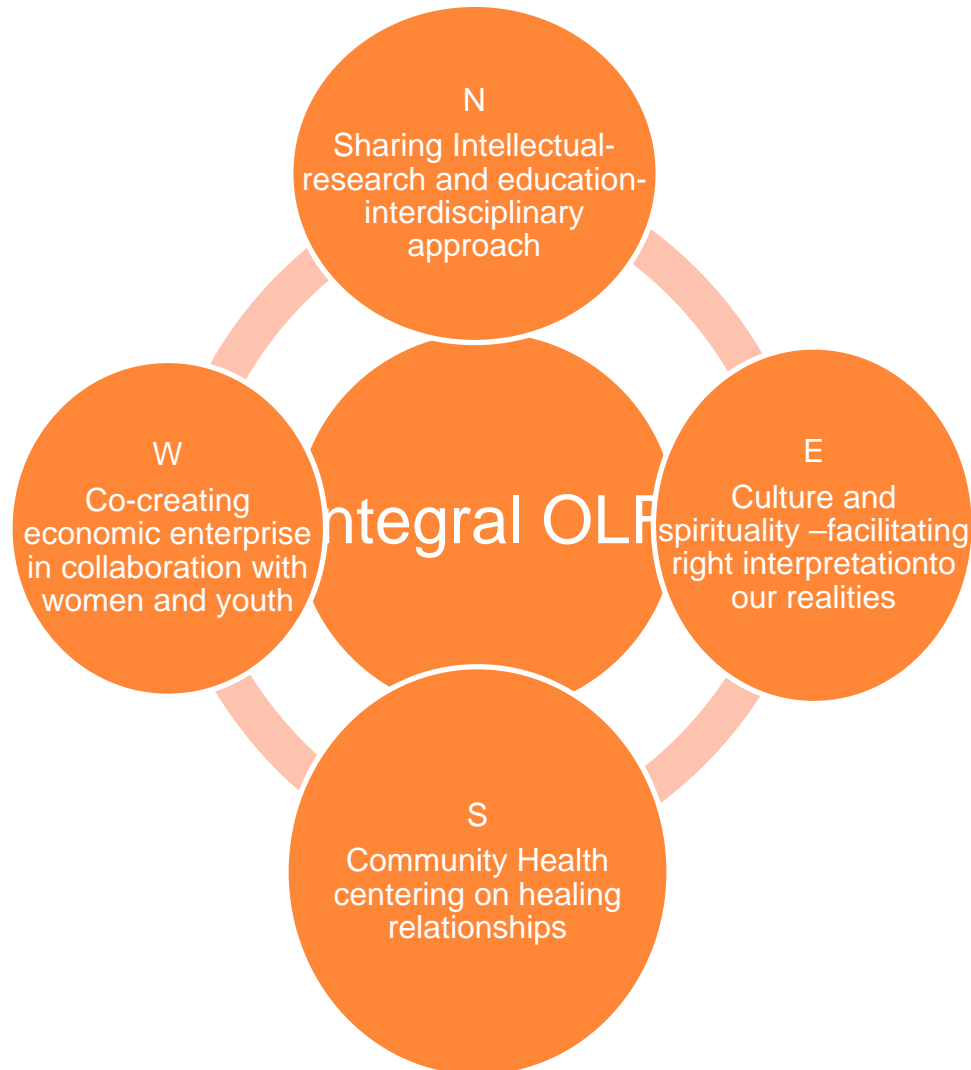


OLF SISTERS' INTEGRAL EDUCATIONAL MODEL
